Al Noor Facility Rental /Al Noor Indoor Sports Facility

Al Noor facilities can be availed for functions, conferences and various other events. There are halls available depending on the size of the event, which includes a multi-purpose hall (which can hold for a maximum of 1000 guests) and the Al Fajer Conference Hall for mid-sized events (which can hold up to 200 guests). The Multifunction Rooms and Classrooms can be utilized for small workshops and meetings. The outdoor covered court; quadrangle, outdoor children's play area and swimming pool are also available for rental. Another highlight is ANISA (Al Noor Indoor Sports Auditorium), one of Dubai's strategically located all-purpose indoor stadiums with upgraded amenities, located in Al Barsha 1. It offers a professional environment and is managed by Ahaad Sports Club.
